WHEREAS, the Board has collected the last of the five annual assessment payments pursuant to an assessment schedule previously adopted by the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Project to be funded by those assessments has not been completed, because the State refused to approve the aeration portion of the project for Bear Lake; and

WHEREAS, the Board has approximately \$300,000 in unused funds at this point; and

WHEREAS, the project has many other uncompleted portions which the Board could address by using the unspent funds of approximately \$300,000;

THEREFORE, THE BOARD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS.

- 1. The Board agrees that the fund balance of approximately \$300,000 will be spent on completing other portions of the Bear Lake Improvement Project, excluding aeration.
- 2. By completing other portions of the project to improve Bear Lake, the Board will eventually exhaust the fund balance from the assessments received by the Board over the past five years.
- 3. In the meantime, until the unspent fund balance of approximately \$300,000 has been exhausted or nearly exhausted, the Board will not institute new assessment proceedings. The Board will not institute a new assessment during the calendar year of 2022, to be payable in
